In Telecom Decision CRTC 2020-362, dated 28 October 2020, the Canadian Radio-television and Telecommunications Commission (CRTC) directed that relief for the southern Ontario area code 289/365/905 complex be provided through a Distributed Overlay using new area code 742 effective 16 October 2021. The new area code 742 has since been assigned by the North American Numbering Plan Administrator (NANPA).

The area code 289/365/905 complex consists of 94 Exchange Areas and covers the geographic area surrounding Toronto in southern Ontario. A map showing the location of the area served by the NPA 289/365/905 complex, and a list of the 94 Exchange Areas are attached to this letter.

When the new NPA 742 is introduced, no changes will take place in the dialling plans in the area that is served by the NPA 289/365/905 complex and that will be served by NPA 742. The dialling plan in this area will continue to be:

- All local calls, including Extended Area Service calls, originating within the overlay area and neighbouring NPAs must be dialled with 10 digits; i.e., NPA-NXX-XXXX.
- Toll and alternatively billed calls originating within the overlay area will continue to be dialled with 10 digits after the appropriate prefix digit(s).

All international and domestic Telecommunications Service Providers (TSPs) should ensure that the new NPA 742 is activated throughout their networks by 16 July 2021 which is the start date for network testing.

**The following revised test numbers for the new NPA 742 will be made available effective 16 July 2021. Routing of calls to area code 742 can be verified by dialling the 8378 (TEST) numbers which do not provide answer supervision. Billing of calls to area code 742 can be verified by dialling the 2455 (BILL) numbers which provide answer supervision.**

You have successfully completed a call to the 742 Area Code Test Number at [CARRIER NAME] in Ontario, Canada.

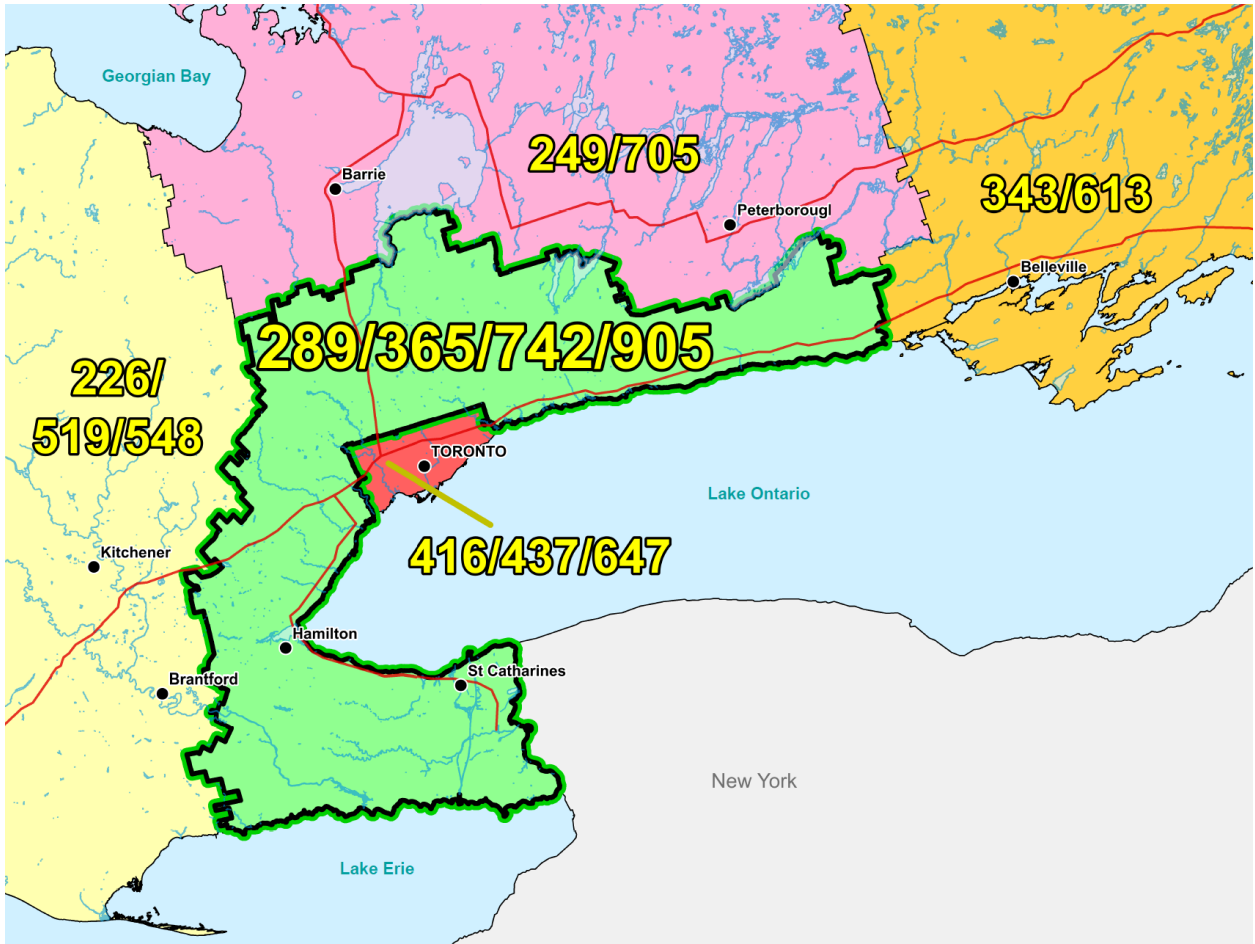
The disconnection dates for the test numbers will be between 15 November 2021 and 20 December 2021.

Central Office (NXX) Codes within NPA 742 may be assigned to TSPs starting from 16 April 2021 but cannot be activated in the PSTN prior to the Relief Date of 16 October 2021.
