General Description

On May 31, 2007, the Kentucky Public Service Commission (KY PSC) in Case No. 2006-00357 ordered a 2-way geographic split as the relief method for the 270 NPA, which serves the western portion of the State of Kentucky. On August 13, 2010, the KY PSC issued an order that suspended the January 1, 2012 permissive dialing date. It was also ordered that the Commission shall continue to monitor developments in the 270 NPA and make a determination as to the future of relief efforts, including implementation dates for permissive dialing, when necessary. The mandatory dialing date shall remain open until further Order by the Commission. A copy of the KY PSC orders and other related Commission information can be obtained at: <http://www.psc.ky.gov/>

Implementation of Relief Plan

Implementation of the split of the 270 NPA is as follows:

	Time	Date
Start of permissive dialing and latest date for all carriers to activate new NPA code	12:01 AM Central	Suspended
End of permissive dialing and start of mandatory dialing of the new NPA	-	TBD
Earliest date for the end of recorded announcement	-	TBD
First date codes from the new NPA may be ordered through NANPA	-	TBD

During the permissive dialing period, either the 270 or the new 364 NPA code will be acceptable in a dialed number terminating in the new 364 NPA.
