Abstract

This IL provides industry notification of the impending split of the 714 NPA.

We have been advised by Pacific Bell that substantial telephone number growth in San Bernardino, Orange, and Riverside County areas necessitates splitting the existing 714 NPA (area code) and the simultaneous introduction of a new 909 NPA. Both NPAs will have interchangeable central office codes (i.e., the second digit of a central office code may be any digit 0-9).

The new 909 NPA will include the majority of the Riverside and southern San Bernardino county areas. Communities such as Riverside, San Bernardino, Ontario, and Pomona will be in the new 909 NPA. The 714 NPA will continue to include the Orange County and Carbon Canyon/Sleepy Hollow areas. Communities such as Anaheim, Santa Ana, and Huntington Beach will remain in the 714 NPA.

The split of the 714 NPA is scheduled for 2:00 AM Pacific Standard Time, Saturday November 14, 1992. There will be a permissive dialing period starting 2:00 AM Pacific Standard Time, Saturday, November 14, 1992 and ending at 2:00 AM Pacific Daylight Savings Time, Saturday August 14, 1993. During the permissive dialing period either 714 or 909 will be acceptable in a dialed number terminating in the new NPA. After the permissive period, calls dialed with incorrect NPA codes, as defined in the NPA split information published in the Local Exchange Routing Guide (LERG), will be routed to intercept. Changes in the local exchange routing information, based on data provided by Pacific Bell, will be incorporated into the LERG and the NPA NXX Activity Guide (NNAG) and be available March 1, 1992.

The dates that switching systems in the new 909 NPA will begin transmitting "909" in the calling number Automatic Number Identification (ANI) will be coordinated by Pacific Bell with the interexchange carriers.

Test calls to verify routing to the new NPA can be made by calling (909) 909-2000. This test number will become available on October 12, 1992, and remain operational for a minimum of 30 days after the end of the permissive period.

The attached map illustrates the 714 and 909 configuration after the split. Furthermore, a listing of the


communities to be served by each area code after the split is included.

The dialing plan for the new 909 NPA will be the same as the existing dialing plan for the 714 NPA:

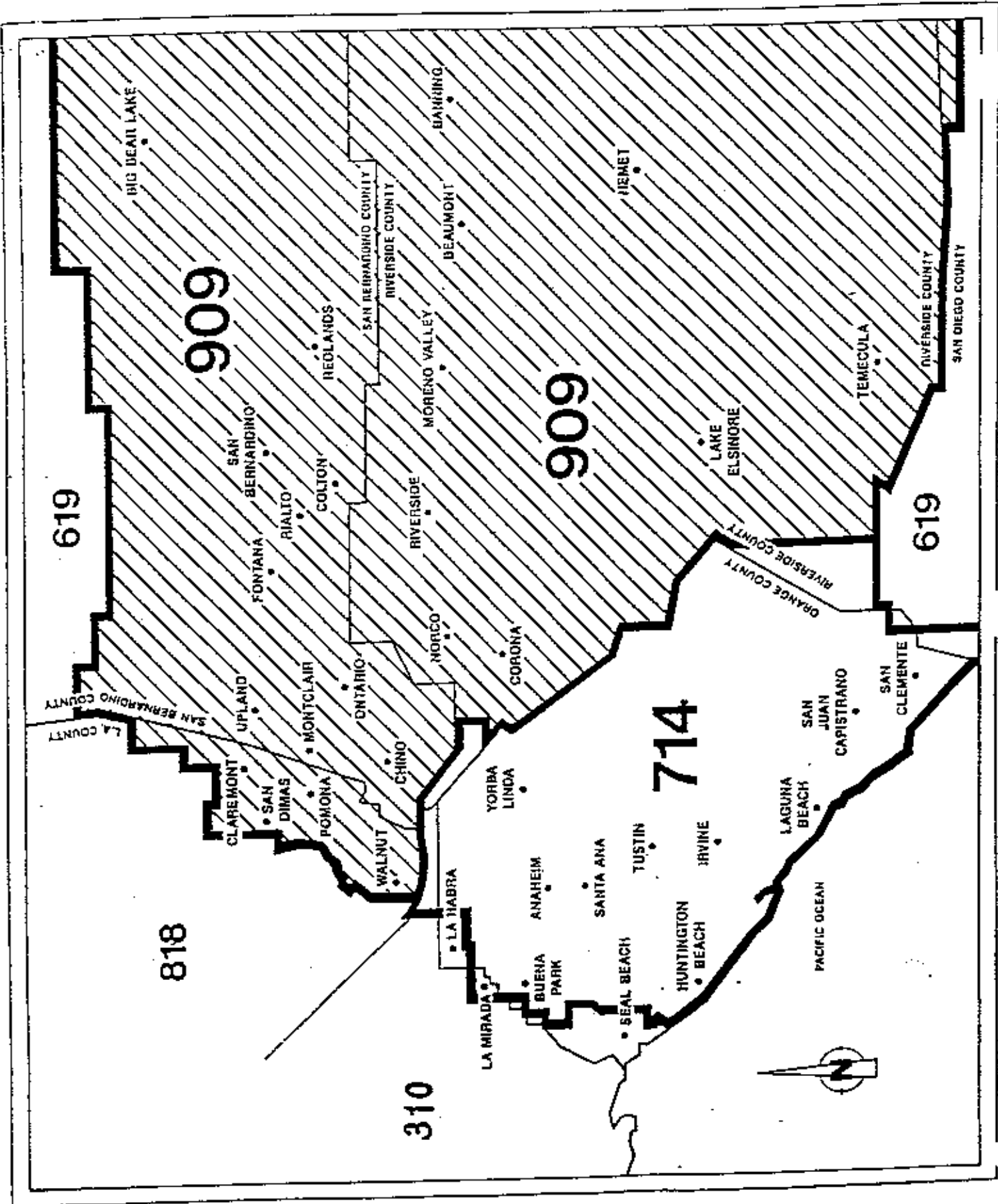
- All home NPA (HNPA) "local" calls (generally calls that do not incur a charge) will be dialed on a 7 digit basis with no prefix; i.e., NXX + XXXX (7 digits).
- All home NPA (HNPA) direct dialed "toll" calls (generally calls that incur a charge) will be dialed on a 7 digit basis with no prefix.
- All foreign NPA (FNPA) direct dialed calls must be dialed with a prefix "1" and 10 digits; i.e., 1 + FNPA + NXX + XXXX (1 + 10 digits).
- Operator assisted calls including credit card calls, collect, and third party calls will be dialed with a "0" prefix and 10 digits; i.e., 0 + NPA + NXX + XXXX (0 + 10 digits).
