Subject: Suspension of Code Assignments in the 586 NPA – Michigan

In light of questions raised by the FCC regarding the authority of NANPA and the Michigan telecommunications industry to implement relief for the 810 NPA, NANPA will suspend all requests for assignment of central office codes from the new 586 NPA pending further direction by the FCC. As documented in Planning Letter 192, the new 586 NPA was to be in service as of May 6, 2000.

NANPA will request FCC approval of the industry's recommended plan for relief of the 810 NPA described in Planning Letter 192 and plans to file a petition with the FCC shortly. It is expected that the FCC will release a public notice requesting public comment on the industry's plan.
