Subject: Revised Mandatory Dialing Date for the 914/845 Split (New York)

On February 9, 2000 NANPA issued planning letter PL-211 announcing the geographic split of the 914 NPA and the addition of the 845 NPA in New York.

At the request of the New York State Department of Public Service and Bell Atlantic, the mandatory dialing date for the 845 NPA has been changed. The new mandatory dialing date is Saturday, December 9, 2000. Performing the required network conversions during a weekend will lessen the possibility of customer impact. Please make note of this change and adjust your implementation schedules accordingly. This change does not affect any of the other information provided in PL-211.
