Subject:	Suspension of Splits of the 707 & 760 NPAs (California)

On July 20, 2000, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) issued Decision 00-07-053, which orders a deferral of the previously adopted implementation schedules for the introduction of new area codes to relieve the 707, and 760 NPAs. The specifics of the decision are as follows:

- The previously adopted implementation plans for the 707 and 760 NPA relief plans are suspended.
- The Commission's decisions previously approving the split relief plans for each of the NPAs referenced above are modified to reflect the suspension. The affected decisions and related Planning Letters (PLs) are as follows:

- Carriers serving customers in the 707 & 760 NPAs shall promptly prepare and mail new notices to customers in those NPAs, but no later than 30 days from the effective date of the order, informing them of the indefinite deferral of the previously scheduled area code splits. If necessary, carriers shall make a separate mailing to customers in order to meet the 30-day deadline.
- Carriers are directed to suspend further activities to implement the relief plans and to reverse any applicable switch translations that have already occurred.
