Subject: NPA 470 To Overlay NPAs 404, 678, and 770

In Docket No.10448-U, the Georgia Public Service Commission (GPSC) approved an all-services overlay of the 404, 678, and 770 NPAs that serve Atlanta, Georgia and surrounding areas. NANPA has assigned NPA code 470 for this purpose. A map showing the area served by these NPAs is attached.

Since 10-digit dialing is already in place for this area, no permissive 10-digit dialing period is necessary

The dialing plan for the Atlanta metropolitan area, including the 404, 770, and 678 NPAs, is summarized below. The 470 NPA will share the same dialing plan after its introduction on September 2, 2001.

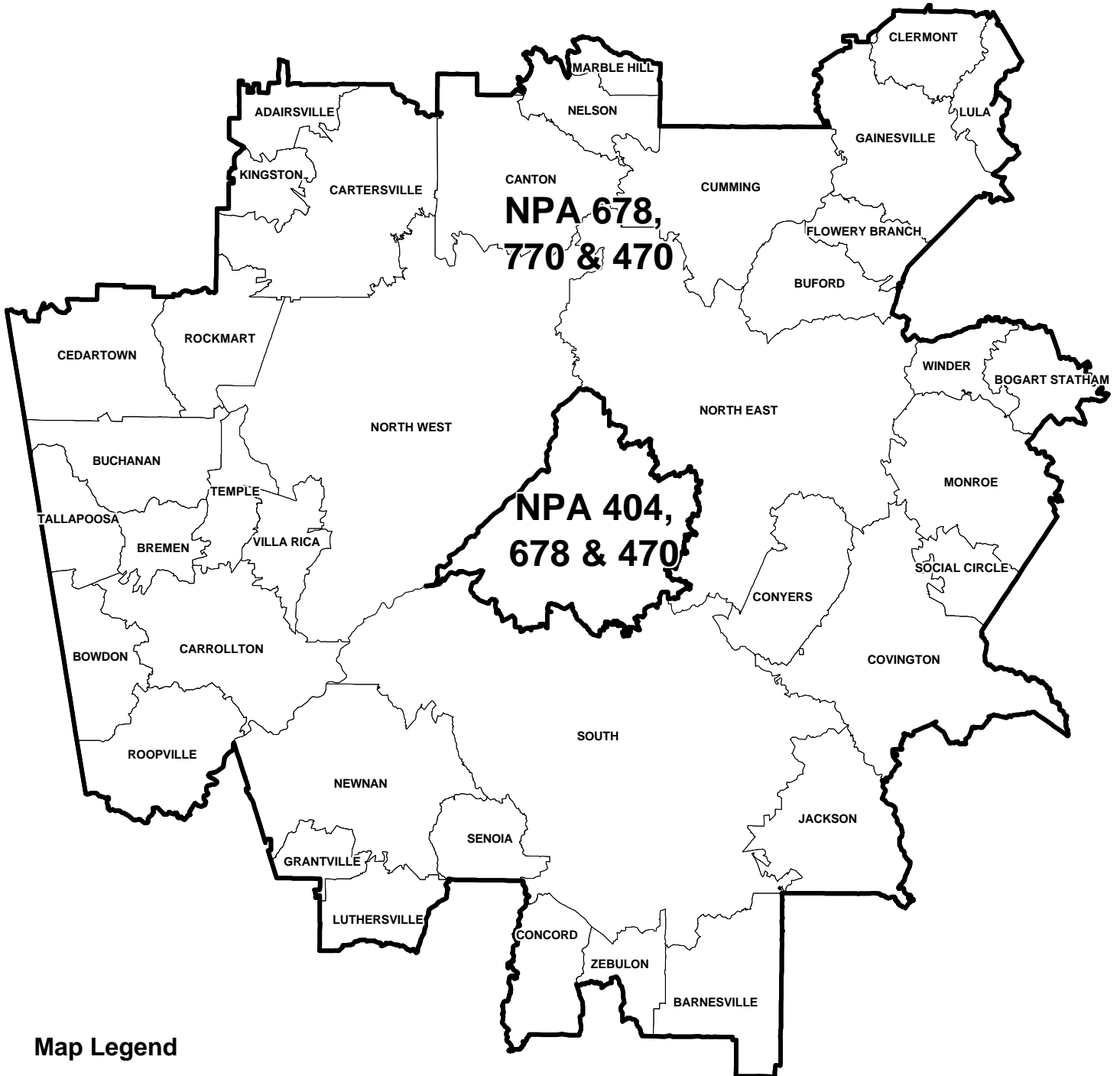
- All local calls must be dialed as 10 digits (NPA+NXX+XXXX).
- All toll calls must be dialed as 1 + 10 digits (1+NPA+NXX+XXXX).
- Operator assisted, third party, and credit calls must be dialed as 0 + ten digits (0+NPA+NXX+XXXX).

All international and domestic carriers should have ensured that the new 470 NPA code has been activated throughout their networks prior to September 2, 2001. Test calls to verify routing to the 470 NPA can be made by dialing the test number 470-666-7777. The test number will be available no later than July 20, 2001. It will remain available until November 1, 2001. A recorded announcement will indicate that the test call has been successfully completed.



NXX codes within the 470 NPA may be assigned to service providers after April 2, 2001, but assigned codes may not be activated prior to September 2, 2001. Per the GPSC Order, all assignable 678 NXX codes must be utilized before a code in the new 470 NPA can be assigned.
