Subject: Declaration of Jeopardy Situation in NPA 614 (Ohio)

We have been advised by Ameritech, central office code administrator for the 614 Numbering Plan Area (NPA) in southeastern Ohio, that the demand for NXX codes in the 614 NPA has increased significantly. As a result, the 614 NPA is in jeopardy of exhausting prior to when relief can be provided. According to the Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines, "A jeopardy condition exists when the forecasted and/or actual demand for NXX resources will exceed the known supply during the planning/implementation interval for relief."

Until relief can be provided, the special conservation measures outlined in Section 8.4 and other appropriate sections of the *Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines* will be invoked for the 614 NPA (refer to document INC 95-0407-008, revision 9/96). In addition, Ameritech has indicated that the following number conservation measures have been agreed to and implemented by the 614 NPA industry team.

- 1. Each industry participant is limited to the quantity of NXXs that were submitted in January 1997, to Wallace Data Comp, as forecast information.
- 2. NXX requests will be fulfilled only if the industry participant can prove activation is required within 6 months to meet service needs.
- 3. Updated industry participant forecasts may be submitted, however, NXX assignment will be limited to No. 1 above.
