Subject: Declaration of Jeopardy Situation in NPA 813 (Florida)

We have been advised by GTE Florida, central office code administrator for the 813 Numbering Plan Area (NPA) in West Central Florida, that the demand for NXX codes in this area is higher than originally projected. As a result, the 813 NPA is in jeopardy of exhausting prior to when relief can be provided. According to the *Central Office Code (NXX) Assignment Guidelines*, "A jeopardy condition exists when the forecasted and/or actual demand for NXX resources will exceed the known supply during the planning/implementation interval for relief."

GTE Florida has indicated that the relief planning process is in the basic stages with industry meetings to be scheduled. No conservation methods will be instituted at this time other than the normal 12 months to exhaust requirement has been lowered to 6 months.
